- C3. Limoges Elite large cake/dessert plate, 12", c.1900 \$ 650
- C4. Limoges mauve and gold small decorative cake plate, 8½", c.1925 ... \$ 200
- C5. Limoges "Ice-cream set".... antique, c.1910-1915 ...
The set includes six 7" plates and one deep platter 8.5" x 15" \$ 1100
- C6. Limoges soft-green with gold oblong cake plate ... c 1891-1914 \$ 450
- C7. Limoges Haviland Candy dish, c. 19th century \$ 450
- C8. Royal Doulton Pitcher, 19th century (special one-of-a-kind pc) \$ 3,000
- C9. Royal Doulton Vase, 19th century (special gold production) \$ 1,400

Russian fine porcelain figurine. This is a very beautiful and high-quality statuette.
Her robe is painted with opalescent glaze, and her features are delicate and very well done. Her necklace is fine gold, and there is gold in the trim of her hat, as well as small amounts on the tea set, and around the base of the piece. Her clothes — especially her 4-sided cap — are true to life, as is even the pattern and color of the Russian tea set.
- C17. Rosenthal "fruit boat" c.1925 \$ 100
The gold edge is fairly worn, but the design is fine.
- C18. Rosenthal "MARIA" painted fruit decorative plate \$ 125
Around 1920 Rosenthal founded a secret formula for the bisque as well as a double firing method at very high temperature, so that a chemical fusion occurs with the glaze, design and the bisque. The ware is highly scratch resistant and, if not for the gold edge, would actually be dishwasher safe. (With repeated use of the dishwasher, the gold edge would slowly be worn away.) This gold edge on this plate is somewhat worn (but there was glaze under). The condition of the painted design is fine.
- C19. Rosenthal round cake plate, c 1920 \$ 65
This plate is ~ 11½" for a 9" cake or cookies. It is in excellent condition, including the gold edge.
